in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. O. Robinson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, about two miles west of Greer on the north side of the old No. 8 National Highway, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of the highway on Lillian Smith's line, and running thence N. 51-30 W. 329 feet to an iron pin at Smith's corner; thence continuing with Smith's line, N. 72-15 W. 560 feet to an iron pin at Smith's corner; thence S. 38-30 W. 480 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76 E. 467 feet to a stone; thence S. 74-15 E. 389 feet to a stone at H. Payne's corner; thence S. 73 E. 82 feet to the center of the highway; thence N. 36-45 E. 334 feet along said highway to the beginning corner, containing 8.39 acres, more or less.

This deed is drawn for the purpose of correcting the description of the within property found in the deed from C. P. Holcombe to A. O. Robinson dated August 13, 1943 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 255, at page 403.
