to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

South Carolina State Highway Department, its successors and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 19 of property of P. L. Bruce, according to a plat of said subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book W, at page 171, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of an unnamed street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19, and running thence N. 34-55 E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20; thence S. 55-05 E. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-55 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 55-05 W. 140 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
