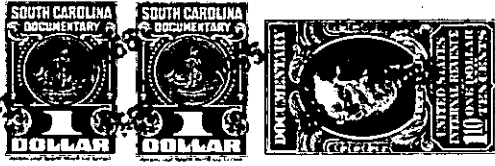

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. Ansel Wilson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 92, Block B, of Orchard Acres, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book BB, at page 103, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Watson Road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 92 and 93 and running thence along the joint line, N. 30-02 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 9-53 E. 151.8 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Ridge Spring Road; thence along said road, S. 30-41 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence E. 54-19 E. 35.4 feet to an iron pin on Watson Road; thence along said road, N. 9-19 W. 125 feet to the beginning corner.

Property in this subdivision is subject to building restrictions set forth in a written instrument dated January 1, 1953, recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Vol. 490, at page 111.
