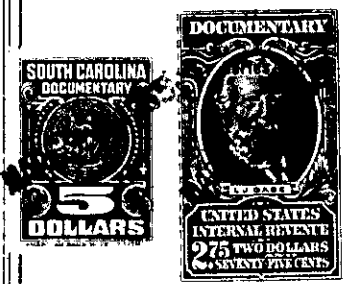

County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot 30, on Plat
of property of Wildair Estates, recorded in Plat Book EE at Page 19,
