to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said HERBERT H. PROVENCE, His heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, situate and being on the Northeast side of Long View Terrace, in City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as all of Lot No. 7 and 30 feet off of the South side of Lot No. 6 adjoining Lot No. 7, according to plat of Forest Heights sub-division made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, which plat is recorded in the office of R.M.C. in and for the County of Greenville in Plat Book "P" at page 71, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Long View Terrace at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, said plat, and running thence with said Long View Terrace N. 63-05 W., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 26-55 E., 153 feet, more or less, to a pin in joint rear line of Lots Nos. 6 and 23, said plat, which pin is 30 feet N. 65-45 W. from joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7, said plat; thence with rear line of said Lots and also with rear line of Lots Nos. 23 and 22, said plat, S. 65-45 E., 100.1 feet to joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8, said plat; thence with joint line of last mentioned Lots S. 26-55 W., 158.3 feet to the point of beginning on Long View Terrace.
