POWER OF ATTORNEY

- 1. To ask, demand, sue for, recover and receive all sums of money, debts, goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, effects and things of whatsoever nature or description, which now are or hereafter shall be or become due, owing, payable or belonging to me in or by any right, title, ways or means howsoever, and upon receipt thereof or of any part thereof to make, sign, execute and deliver such receipts, releases or other discharges for the same respectively as she shall think fit or be advised.
- 2. To settle any account or reckoning whatsoever wherein I now am or at any time hereafter shall be in any wise interested in or concerned with any person whomsoever, and to pay or receive the balance thereof as the case may require.
- 3. To sell, either at public or private sales, or exchange any part or parts of my personal property, for such consideration and upon such terms as Joan D. Bensch, my attorney shall think fit, and to execute and deliver good and sufficient instruments for the conveyance or transfer of the same, with such covenants of warranty or otherwise as Joan D. Bensch, my attorney, shall see fit. I particularly give to Joan D. Bensch, my attorney in fact, full power and authority to sell or trade my automobile for another automobile, and the said Joan D. Bensch, my attorney is given full power and authority for me and in my name to execute all necessary papers, to convey to the purchaser, whoever he may be, the aforesaid premises with good and sufficient warranty title to same; and to purchase from any seller chosen by Joan D.
