all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances: Beginning on a pine running thence N. 48.10 E., 1260 feet to a stake in the road, thence, with the road S.20.10 E. 387 feet to a bend in the road. Thence, S. 2.30 E., 450 feet to a stake in the road, thence, S. 52.30 W., 1050 feet to a stake on the Henderson line, thence, N. 63.00 W., with the Henderson line 740 feet to a stone. Thence N. 55.15 E., 490 feet to a pine the beginning corner containing 22.85 Acres more or less.
