to say: To dispose, sell, store or otherwise handle all my household goods in any
way deemed expedient to my said attorney. To rent, lease or sell the real property
and all buildings, improvements or appurtenances thereto, at 10 Waverly Court,
Greenville, South Carolina. This power of Attorney shall be valid and operative for
three years from the date of execution by me, unless sooner revoked, at which time it
shall become null and void, and of no force and effect.
GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney full power and authority to
do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in the
premises, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or
could do in my own proper person if personally present; and hereby ratify all
that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these
presents.

And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my
said attorney shall be binding on myself, and my heirs, legal and personal
representatives and assigns; whether the same shall have been done before or
after my death or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until
reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by my said
attorney; and whether or not I, the grantor of this instrument, shall have
been reported or listed, either officially or otherwise, as "missing" or
"missing in action" as those words are used in military parlance, it being
the intendant hereof that such status designation shall not bar my attorney
from fully and completely exercising and continuing to exercise any and all
powers and rights herein granted, and that such report of "missing" or
"missing in action" shall neither constitute nor be interpreted as consti-
tuting notice of my death nor operate to revoke this instrument.

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
