

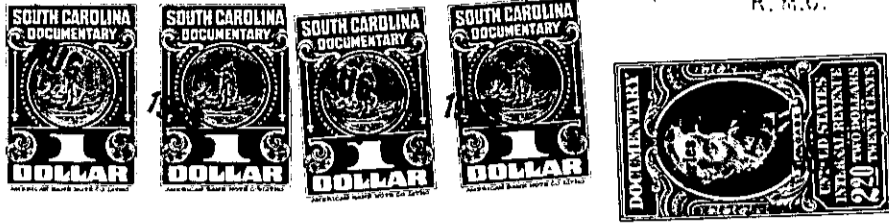

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Robert Thompson, Sallic T. Lomax, Janie T. Hunter, Hattie Mae Thompson, Sadie Mae Hammond, Teresa Margaret Thompson, Willie B. Thompson and Olivia Covington,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of -----  
Fifteen Hundred Seventy-five and no/100 - - - (\$1575.00) - - - - Dollars  
to ----- us ----- in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by ----- Mrs. Flora Scott -----

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Flora Scott, ----- her heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in ----- Township,  
County, State of South Carolina

All of our right, title, interest and estate in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of the Alverson lands and according to a plat of the same made by W. D. Neves, Engineer, September 13, 1920, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at page 296, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Haynie Street, which pin is 50 feet east of the intersection of Haynie Street and Boling Street, and running thence along Haynie Street, N. 30-45 E., 42 feet more or less to an iron pin; thence N. 10-30 W., 96 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Hardy Alley; thence along Hardy Alley, S. 10-45 W., 42 feet more or less to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots 4 and 5; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 10-30 E., 95 feet to the point of beginning, and being identically the same lot conveyed to the said Robert T. Thompson by J. N. Alverson by deed dated December 31, 1923, recorded in Deed Book 92 at page 261.
