to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

LEITTA CAPPS FARMER, her heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of Hall Road near the City of Greenville, being designated as the Lot of F. A. Capps on plat of property of Timms, Bryant, Capps, Langley, et al, on Hall Road, made by C. C. Jones in November, 1956, recorded in Plat Book KK at page 83, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of Hall Road at a corner of property designated as the lot of Lola Timms and running thence with the line of said property, N. 46-11 E. 207.7 feet to a stake; thence N. 58-58 W. 136.8 feet to a stake near a branch; thence with the branch as the line, the traverse of which is S. 33-37 W. 200.7 feet to a point in the center of Hall road; thence with said road S. 60-40 E. 88.2 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property which was conveyed to F. A. Capps by deed recorded in Deed Book 297 at page 442, the said F. A. Capps died testate on September 22, 1949 and by his Will filed as Apartment 650 at page 48, devised the property to his mother, Armina Capps and his sister, Leitta Capps Farmer, for life with the remainder to his children, J. B. Capps, William Capps, Ruth Ellison and Margie Smith; Armina Capps has since died and the grantor, J. B. Capps, joins in this deed to convey his remainder interest to the grantee.
