To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, William Robert Cooke, by his Guardian ad Litem, George C. Cooke,

on or about the 12th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-seven exhibited his complaint in the County Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Thomas McAfee Funeral Home, a Corporation,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of April 1957, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Thomas McAfee Funeral Home, a Corporation, for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear: (See Judgment Roll No. G-7489)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$692.83

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Thomas McAfee Funeral Home, a Corporation, all the right, title and interest of the minor Plaintiff, William Robert Cooke, in and to the following described real estate:

"All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, situate and being on the south side of West Stone Avenue, in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of West Stone Avenue, corner of lot now or formerly owned by the C. S. Webb Estate, which point is 182.25 feet west of North Main Street, and running thence with line of said property S. 20-00 W. 164 feet to other property of grantee (formerly Haynsworth lot); thence with line of said property N. 84 1/2 W. 122.25 feet to (now or formerly) wood's line; thence with wood's line N. 20 E. 164 feet to iron pin on the South side of West Stone Avenue; thence with the South side of West Stone Avenue S. 84 1/2 E. 122.25 feet to the point of beginning, and being the same property conveyed to the late Bess E. Shockley by Mable S. Smith, et al, deed dated July 31, 1936, recorded in the office of R.M.C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 198, Page 98, and deed of E. Inman, Master, dated March 22, 1937, recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book Vol. 159, Page 437."
