That I, J. O. Shaver, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 -- - DOLLARS,

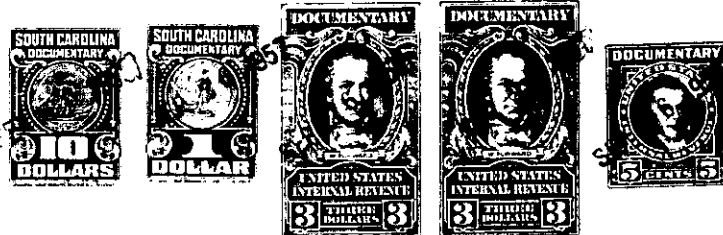
