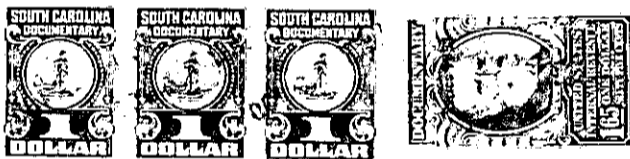

STEVENS & CO., INC. owning property and having a a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Delaware and ~~located at its principal~~ place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-five and No/100ths (\$1,235.00)-----dollars, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee(s) hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto HENRY E. ROBINSON AND LILLIE J. ROBINSON:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the North-western side of the intersection of Monaview Street and Lindsay Street, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 77 as shown on a plat entitled "Monaghan Subdivision, Section Two" made by Piedmont Engineering Service, Greenville, S.C., May 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at page 151, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Monaview Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 76 and 77, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 76 N. 38-30 E. 160 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 78; thence with the line of Lot No. 78 S. 51-30 E. 135.7 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Lindsay Street; thence with the Northwestern side of Lindsay Street S. 30-45 W. 134.4 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57-57 W. 28.7 feet to an iron pin on the Northeastern side of Monaview Street; thence with the Northeastern side of Monaview Street N. 51-30 W. 125.2 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to restrictive covenants applicable to Monaghan Subdivision, Section Two, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 581 at page 309, and to an easement for the construction, maintenance and operation of a power distribution line given by J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc. to Duke Power Company, dated September 9, 1957, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 584 at page 137.



Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
