

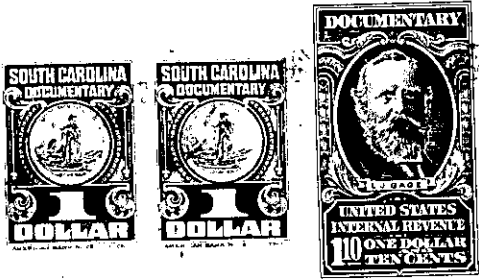

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, Known and designated as a northern portion of Lot
No. 26 on Glen Road, as shown on Plat thereof by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor,
August 26, 1943, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat
Book "M", at page 75, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint back corners of lots Nos. 26 and
25 on the Northwest side of Glen Road, and running thence with the common line
