All our right, title and interest in and to all that lot of land in Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of Ackley Street in the City

made by Piedmont Engineering Service on May 15, 1952, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Ackley Street, at the corner of Lot 2
and running thence with the line of said Lot, S. 6-27 E. 198.4 feet to a stake in
line of Lot 4; thence with the line of said lot, S. 80-04 W. 70 feet, more or less,
to a stake at the corner of property now or formerly owned by Sylvia Foster; thence
