All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township lying at the intersection of N. Parker Road and Old Poorhouse Road, being known as part of tract No. 80 of the Parker Land Company and having according to a plat prepared for D. U. Mauldin by C. C. Jones, Engineer, dated March 15, 1958 the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of Old Poorhouse Road where the same intersects with the center of N. Parker Road and running thence with the center of the Old Poorhouse Road, N. 46-53 E. 372 feet to a nail and cap; thence leaving said road and running N. 46-17 W. 269.6 feet to a nail and cap in the center of N.
