KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Oscar Lee McDonald of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars and other considerations Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

by John W. King (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W. King all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Oak Lawn Township, Greenville County, and State aforesaid and being more fully described as follows,

Beginning at an iron pin on John W. King's line at Arthur Payer corner and running thence along Kings line N. 8-40- W. ^{350.5'} 31 chains to center of the new road leading from Fork Shoals to old Hundred, thence along said new road ^{350.5'} 36 c. 5' 10" to iron pin in center of said road.

Thence S. 0-7-20- W. ^{71.3'} 1.08 to the beginning corner and containing twenty eight one hundredths ^{28/100} of one acre.

The above described land is a part of the same conveyed to me by W. H. Massey on the 22 day of Nov. 19 23, deed recorded in office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 92 Page 276
