to me paid by the said The South Carolina National Bank of Greenville, S.C. a Corporation as Trustee under Agreement with Bessie Norris Tilman, dated July 9, 1953,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these

Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said

The South Carolina National Bank of Greenville, S. C., a Corporation, as Trustee under Agreement with Bessie Norris Tilman, dated July 9, 1953

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, now within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as all of Lot 80 and the southern portion of Lot No. 81, of a subdivision known as Augusta Road Ranches, as shown on plat there of recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, at Page 47, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
