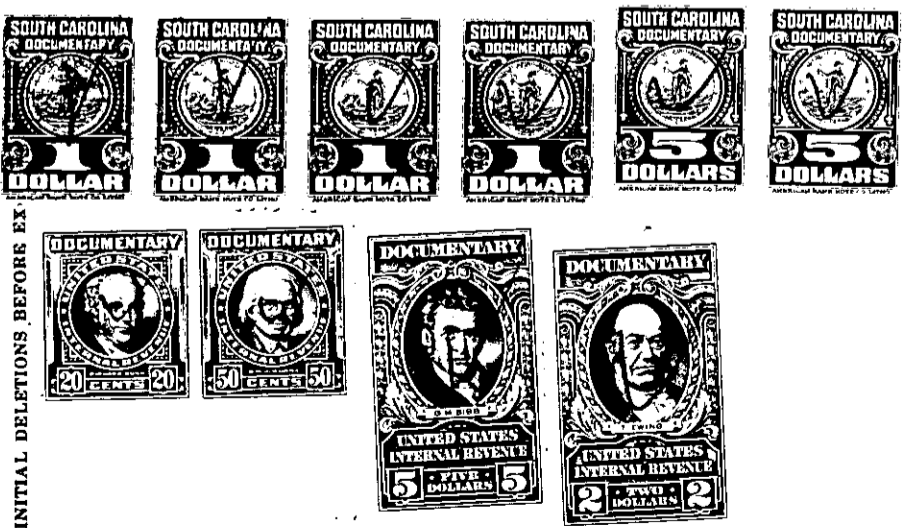

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Sumter Street, near the City of Greenville, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 3 on the Plat of the property of Talmer Cordell made by Dalton & Neves in July, 1949, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book V, page 193, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northerly side of Sumter Street at a point located 126.6 feet east of the northeasterly corner of the intersection of Sumter Street and Texas Avenue, said pin being the joint corner of Lots 2 and 3, and running thence along the northerly side of Sumter Street N 71-00 E 62 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 3 and 4; thence along the joint line of said Lots N 22-10 W 132.5 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots 3 and 16; thence along the joint line with Lot 16 S 71-00 W 62 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lots 1 and 3; thence along the line with Lots 1 and 2 S 22-10 E 132.5 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same property conveyed to William F. Merritt by deed of Fred Dorn Dykes, dated September 21, 1955, and recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 535, page 287.
