All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, north of and near Rutherford (old Camp) Road, on Northern side of Emory Street, being the rear portion of and, according to said plat, in part, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
