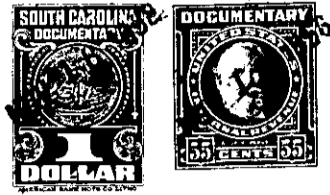

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said **SARAH A. BISHOP AND MYRAN C. BISHOP:**

All the right, title and interest of the minor defendant, Judy Lee
Smith, the same being an undivided one-sixth (1/6th) interest in and
to the following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Green-
ville County, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Watson
Road, and being shown as Lots Nos. 56 and 62 on Plat of the property of
Vance Edwards, recorded in Plat Book P at pages 128 and 129, said plat
having been subsequently revised, and having, according to said plat as
revised, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
