All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the southwest side of Artillery Road, near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 4 and Lot #5, as shown on a plat prepared by Dalton & Neves, dated June, 1939, for Robert J. Edwards, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5, as shown on a more recent plat prepared by C. C. Jones, dated December, 1957, entitled "Property of Leslie & Shaw, Inc.", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Caroline, in Plat Book PP at page 19, and having according to the last mentioned plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Artillery Road, which iron pin is located 196 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the intersection of Meridan Avenue and Artillery Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; and running thence with the line of Lot No. 4, S. 59-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 30-30 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 59-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Antillery Road; thence with the Southwestern side of Artillery Road, N. 30-30 W. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
