POWER OF ATTORNEY - GENERAL

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Kenneth W. Hill,
a legal resident of the (Town, City or County) of Taylors
State of South Carolina, United States of America, now in the
Military Service as a Staff Sergeant, Air Force Serial No. AF 14 339 881
in the Air Force of the United States, and anticipating that I may be required to go
overseas in said military service, have made, constituted and appointed and by these
presents do make, constitute and appoint my wife, Carrie L. Hill
whose address is Route #3, E. Lee Road, Taylors, South Carolina
my true and lawful attorney to act in, manage, and conduct all my estate and all my
affairs, and for that purpose for me and in my name, place, and stead, and for my use
and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and execute, or to concur with persons
jointly interested with myself therein in the doing or executing of, all or any of the
following acts, deeds, and things, that is to say:

(1) To buy, receive, lease, accept, or otherwise acquire; to sell, convey, mort-
gage, hypothecate, pledge, quit claim, or otherwise encumber or dispose of; or to con-
tract or agree for the acquisition, disposal, or encumbrance of; any property whatso-
ever or any custody; possession, interest, or right therein, upon such terms as my
said attorney shall think proper; (2) to take, hold, possess, invest, lease, or let,
or otherwise manage any or all of my property or any interest therein; to eject, re-
move, or relieve tenants or other persons from, and recover possession of, such prop-
erty by all lawful means and to maintain, protect, preserve, insure, remove, store,
transport, repair, rebuild, modify, or improve the same or any part thereof; (3) to
make, do and transact all and every kind of business of what nature or kind soever,
including the receipt, recovery, collection, payment, compromise, settlement and
adjustment of all accounts, legacies, bequests, interest, dividends, annuities, demands,
debts, taxes and obligations, which may now or hereafter be due, owing, or payable to
me; (4) to make, indorse, accept, receive, sign, seal, execute, acknowledge, and de-
liver deeds, assignments, agreements, certificates, hypothecations, checks, notes,
bonds, vouchers, receipts, and such other instruments in writing of whatever kind and
nature as may be necessary, convenient, or proper in the premises; (5) to deposit and
withdraw for the purposes hereof, in either my said attorney's hands name or my name
or jointly in both our names, in or from any banking institution any funds, negotiable
paper, or moneys which may come into my said attorney's hands as such attorney or
which I now or hereafter may have on deposit or be entitled to; (6) to institute,
prosecute, defend, compromise, arbitrate, and dispose of legal, equitable, or adminis-
trative hearings, actions, suits, attachments, arrests, distresses or other proceed-
ings, or otherwise engage in litigation in connection with the premises; (7) to act
as my attorney or proxy in respect to any stocks, shares, bonds, or other investments,
rights or interests, I may now or hereafter hold; (8) to engage and dismiss agents,
counsel, and employees, and to appoint and remove at pleasure any substitute for, or
agent of my said attorney, in respect to all or any of the matters or things herein
mentioned and upon such terms as my attorney shall think fit; (9) to execute vouchers
in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by
th United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for
transportation of dependents or for shipment or household effects as authorized by
law and Army Regulations, and to receive, indorse, and collect the proceeds of checks
payable to the other of the undersigned drawn on the Treasury of the United States;
(10) to prepare, execute, and file income and other tax returns, and other govern-
mental reports, applications, requests and documents; (11) to take possession, and
order the removal and shipment of any of my property from any Post, warehouse, depot,
dock, or other place or storage or sagekeeping, governmental or private; and to exe-
cute and deliver any release, voucher, receipt, shipping ticket, certificate, or
other instrument necessary or convenient for such purposes. (12) This power of
attorney is void after 1 January 1960.
