did on the 31st day of December, 1959, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREENVILLE ENGRAVERS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

4th. That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is (a) To buy, sell, manufacture and carry on the business of engravers, printers and designers by fabricating, etching and otherwise forming and making metal plates, cylinders and other material items for such purposes; and to engage generally in the art, trade, and business of engraving, printing, stamping and all other methods of printing, engraving and/or stamping designs and pictures upon articles of the engraving and printing trade, including textiles, plastics, paper, foil, and other kindred materials. (b) To buy, sell, rent, manufacture, install, use, operate and generally deal in and with machines, mechanisms, devices, apparatus, inventions and improvements for engraving, printing, stamping, duplicating, casing or making impressions of pictures, designs and drawings, and all other things for use in or in connection with the engravers' art, trade and business. (c) To apply for, obtain, purchase and otherwise acquire, and to register, hold, own, use, operate, sell, assign, or otherwise dispose of and turn to account and profit any and all trademarks, improvements, processes, formulae, trade secrets, inventions and apparatus of all kinds, either secured under letters patent of the United States or in any foreign country or in any other manner. (d) To purchase, lease, acquire, hold, mortgage, and convey real and personal property; to purchase the business, good will and all other assets of any individual, firm or corporation as a going concern, and to assume all its obligations. (e) Generally, to perform all acts authorized for corporations under the laws of South Carolina, and to perform any and all acts which may be deemed necessary or expedient pursuant to and in connection with the foregoing objects, purposes and powers.
