I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Georgia Lee Gibson Wilson, et al,  
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on or about the 10th day of September in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and Sixty exhibited their

complaint in the ~~Court of Common Pleas~~ Court for the County aforesaid, against  
Patrick Elliott Wilson (formerly Broadus Patterson Wilson, Jr.), in-  
dividually and as representatives of all the children born or unborn,  
of Georgia Lee Gibson Wilson, et al,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to  
be heard on the 30th day of September 1960,  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to George A. Christenberry and Elizabeth R. Christenberry  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
unto the said George A. Christenberry and Elizabeth R. Christenberry

"All that lot of land in the City of Greenville, State and County  
aforesaid, on the south side of West Earle Street between Townes and Wilton  
Streets, and being the western half of Lot No. 4 as shown by plat of lands  
of the Stone Land Company recorded in Deed Book VV, Page 542, having the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
BEGINNING at an iron pin on Earle Street, corner of lot now or form-  
erly owned by A. E. Sussex, and running thence with Sussex line, S. 5½  
W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84½ W. 65½ feet to an iron pin;  
thence N. 5½ E. 200 feet to an iron pin on Earle Street; thence with Earle  
Street S. 84½ E. 65½ feet to the beginning."  
The purchase price of the property herein conveyed is \$17,000.00 and  
the same was paid by the grantees direct to the South Carolina National  
Bank of Charleston, Greenville, S. C., as Trustee, as provided for in the  
Decree of Court herein.
