in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and correction of deed in the State aforesaid, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James A. Wood, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and being shown as Lot No. 16 on a plat of the property of C. W. Wood prepared by Jones and Sutherland, Engineers, January 28, 1960, recorded in Plat Book UU at Page 80, and, according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Eunice Drive, at the joint front corner of Lots 15 and 16, and running thence with the common line of said lots, S. 87-07 E., 201.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-56 W., 108.7 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 17; thence with the line of said lot, N. 88-47 W., 174.0 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Eunice Drive; thence with said drive, S. 2-53 W., 100 feet to the point of beginning.
