That I, Benjamin Furman Watkins, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS, and other consideration to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Alfred C. Mann, his Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the northwestern side of Camelback Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of Unit 1, Canterbury Hills, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "MM", at Page 150 and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Camelback Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 43-06 W. 145 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 46-54 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 5, S. 43-06 E. 145 feet to an iron pin; thence along said Road, N. 46-54 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
