



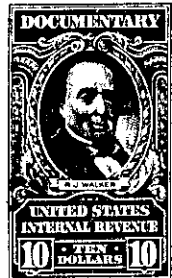
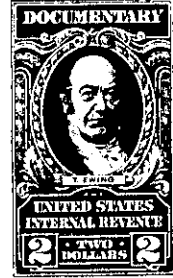

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Piedmont Lumber Co.,

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina  
and having its principal place of business at  
Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration  
of the sum of Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$10,950.00) Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee S  
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto William T.  
Coleman and Blanche Robertson Coleman, their Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Paris Mountain  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southern side of  
Trammell Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 7 on plat of Property  
of James H. Trammell, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-  
ville County in Plat Book "NN", at Page 145 and having according to said plat the  
following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Trammell Road at the joint  
front corner of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 and running thence along said Road, S. 38-18 W.  
113.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 29-00 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N.  
61-00 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 29-00 W. 202.9 feet to the point of  
beginning.
