ALL THAT piece, parcel or tract of land situated in said State and County, Chick Springs Township, adjoining lands of Jos. Gilliard, J. B. Brookshire, F. M. Taylor, Simon Foster, J. B. Hudson and others, the same being more particularly described in a Deed, less any portions sold, from A. C. Wood to R. L. Goodwin, dated October 14, 1908, and recorded in Deed Volume ZZZ, Page 403, Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, and currently noted as being in Tax District 265, Sheet 28, Block 1, Lot 7, now containing 36 Acres, more or less,
