J. Leonard and Frances U. Leonard, their Heirs and Assigns forever:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 81, 82 and 83 of Paris View, Section #2, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "ZZ", Page 91 and being described according to said plat as follows:

LOT NO. 81: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Manley Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 80 and 81 and running thence N. 39-55 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 51-10 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 82, S. 39-55 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on Manley Street; thence along Manley Street, S. 51-10 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

LOT NO. 82: BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Manley Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 81 and 82 and running thence N. 39-55 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 51-10 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 83, S. 39-55 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on Manley Street; thence along Manley Street, S. 51-10 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

LOT NO. 83: BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northeastern corner of the intersection of Manley Street and a County Road and running thence along said County Road, N. 48-E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said County Road, N. 50-24 E. 103.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 51-10 E. 112 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 82, S. 39-55 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of Manley Street; thence along Manley Street, N. 51-10 W. 145.4 feet to the beginning corner.
