

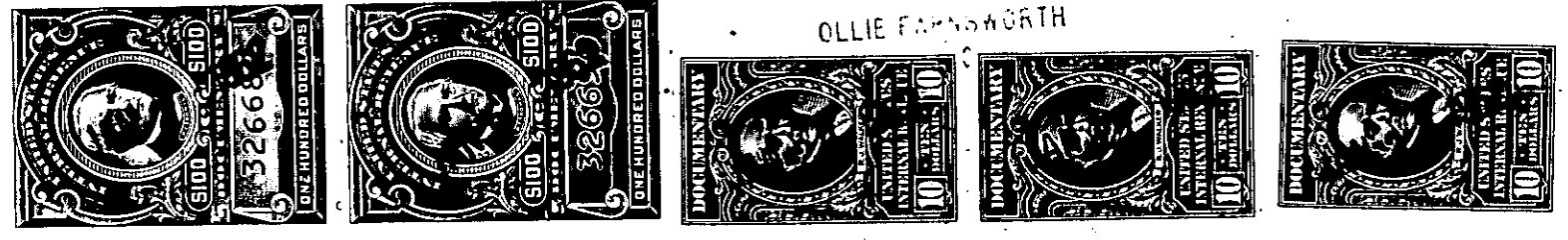

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto CROMPTON & KNOWLES CORPORATION, a Massachusetts corporation:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, containing 1.59 acres, more or less, situate, lying and being approximately one mile North of the Town of Simpsonville, Austin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 4 as shown on a plat prepared by W.J.
