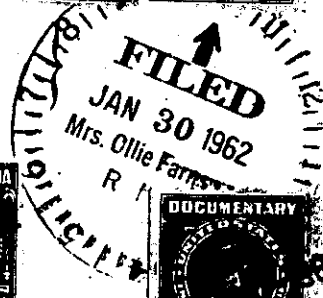


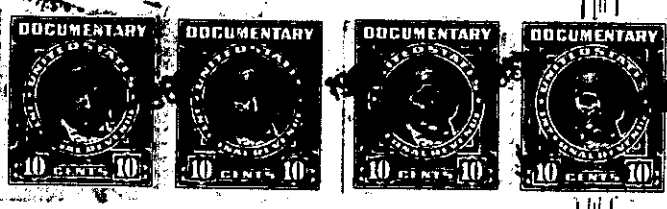

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

BEGINNING on an old iron pin on Julian Calhoun's land, and running
thence North 21 deg. 01 min. East 184.4 feet to an iron pin; thence
