TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said right of way and easement unto said Grantee, its successors and assigns, until the first equipment is installed and so long thereafter as cathodic protection equipment is maintained thereon; and the undersigned hereby bind themselves, their heirs, executors and administrators (and successors and assigns) to warrant and forever defend all singular premises unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. The Grantee shall have the right to assign this grant in whole or in part.

In the event this grant shall terminate or be terminated for any cause, Grantee shall have the right to remove any equipment or installation placed on the property above described and shall have a reasonable time after such termination within which to effect such removal.

It is understood that this grant covers all of the agreements between the parties hereto and that no statements, written or verbal, have been made which modify or change the terms hereof.
