in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of -----

to us ----- in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by JOHN D. HUFF -----

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John D. Huff, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that tract or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing in the aggregate eight (8) acres, more or less. BEGINNING at a stone on Augusta Road; thence S. 44 E., 12.30 to stone; thence S. 63 1/2 W. 4.50 to stone in center of road; thence N. 25 3/4 W. 11.90 to stone in road; thence N. 63 1/2 E. 82 feet to the beginning corner, containing 3.32 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Mrs. Sicily Vance, William Scott and others.

THAT other tract adjoining the above tract: BEGINNING at stone in road; thence S. 44 E. 3.50 to stone; thence N. 54 E 5.75 to stone 3x; thence S. 54 W. to stone 3 x at beginning corner, containing two acres, more or less. Bounded by lands of H. S. Davenport and Mrs. Sicily Vance.
