CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

A. B. Taylor, Jr., Route 4, Orchard Drive, Greenville, S. C.
and

George R. Lowrance, 44 Ivy Drive, Mauldin, S. C.

did on the 10th day of June, 1963, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **EVERGOOD MEATS, INCORPORATED**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **120 West Trade Street, Simpsonville, S. C.**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is **to manufacture, process, distribute and sell meat and meat products of every kind and nature at retail and/or wholesale, and other real and personal property of all kinds at retail and/or wholesale and to do all other things necessary or incident to the conduct of such a business.**

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00)** Dollars payable **in cash or property**

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **Twenty Thousand (20,000)** of the par value of **One (\$1.00)** Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **7th** day of **June**, 1963, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **A. B. Taylor, Jr., George R. Lowrance, Thomas C. Brissey, V. M. Wells, A. L. Lorance**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **A. B. Taylor, Jr.** ;
as Vice-President, **George R. Lowrance** ; as Secretary, **Thomas C. Brissey** ;
as Treasurer, **George R. Lowrance**

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by *bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **The Greenville Piedmont**

a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
