COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.) SEPARATION AGREEMENT.

We, John Ray Fisher, Husband, and Dorothy M. Fisher, Wife, hereby enter into the following separation agreement.

Whereas, we have agreed to enter into a separation agreement in a friendly and agreeable manner, because we cannot live together as husband and wife in peace and harmony without keeping our two children in a state of frustration, we have decided it would be better for our children that we live separate and apart.

It is agreed that wife is to have the custody of the two children, Thomas Ray Fisher, Son, age 14 and Dorothy Jane Fisher, Daughter, age 11, and husband is to have the right to visit children at wife's home any time in an agreeable manner without molesting wife, and husband is to have children every other week-end to be with him where he is living; Husband is to give to wife One Hundred and Sixty Dollars per month or Eight Dollars every two weeks for the support of children and to help her with house payments on home deeded to her this day by husband at No. 408 Tryon Street in City of Greer, said County, there being \$10,400.00 balance due on said seven and half room house at Woodruff Fed., Savings & Loan Assoc., at Woodruff, S.C., said property being appraised at \$22,500.00. That husband is to keep up said monthly payments as long as he is not disabled and it is further agreed that when each child marries or becomes self supporting One third of this amount is to be eliminated and in case wife re-marries after divorce, that husband is to be relieved of such payments except as to children.

Wife agrees to forever release, relinquish and cancel all dower rights and interest she has any and all real estate now owned by husband and in which he may have title to in the future in lieu of consideration of deed to house and lot with equity of about Twelve Thousand and too the agreement of husband to provide said One Hundred and Sixty Dollars per month to wife according to above conditions. This consideration being deemed to be sufficient to justify release ~~all~~ of all dower rights and interests of wife in husband's lands now and in the future.

It is further agreed that neither husband nor wife is to molest, interfere with nor meddle in the affairs of the other and that this agreement will not, in any way, interfere with any divorce action by either party in the future.
