AGREEMENT

WHEREAS the undersigned parties have reached an agreement preparatory to filing a decree for divorce in the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court for Greenville County, the parties do hereby mutually agree as follows:

I.

That the first party will pay to the second party for the maintenance and support of the children of said parties the sum of Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) per week with an additional sum of Eighteen and No/100 Dollars (\$18.00) per week to be used to defray the cost of special schooling for David Collins so long as is needed. This Eighteen and No/100 Dollars (\$18.00) payment is to be credited against a note of even date with this agreement in the sum of Two Thousand Thirty-Three and 75/100 Dollars (\$2,033.75). The total of these payments will be paid monthly for a total of Two Hundred Ninety-Five and No/100 (\$295.00) per month. The first monthly payment of Two Hundred Ninety-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$295.00) to the Clerk of Court of Greenville County shall begin on November 15, 1963, and continue on the fifteenth day of each month thereafter until the special schooling for David ceases, at which time the monthly payments shall then be Two Hundred Sixteen and 66/100 Dollars (\$216.66) a month until further agreement of the parties or until further ordered by the court. It is agreed that the decree should order this payment to be made to the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina.

II.

The first party owns property jointly with E. F. Breazeale located on U. S. Highway 29 North and the first party agrees that the second party shall receive the sum of Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00) to be derived from the sale of four (4) lots to Mr. J. B. Bowers of Greenville County, South Carolina. It is understood and agreed that this Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00) is to apply against the back payments for support ordered by the Greenville County Juvenile Court and that the above referred note is given as a
