KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, John A. Park, of Greenville, South Carolina, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son, Charles A. Park, as my true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with the following powers and duties:

1. He is hereby vested with full power and authority to transact all business for me, including the right to collect all sums due to me, to receipt for same and to deposit the said sums in a bank account in my name.

2. He is further vested with full power to sign checks on any bank account belonging to me; and to withdraw any funds from savings in Federal Savings and Loan Associations.

3. He is empowered to lease, sell and convey any and all property owned by me upon such terms and at such prices as he may deem wise in his absolute discretion.

4. He is further empowered to do all things for me which I could do if personally present, and all instruments of every nature and kind executed by him as my attorney-in-fact under the authority contained in this instrument shall be valid and binding upon me in the same manner and to the same extent as if I had personally executed or
