12. To substitute and appoint in her place and stead, upon such terms and at such salary or compensation as she shall think fit, one or more persons to exercise for me as my attorney or attorneys any or all of the powers and authorities hereby conferred, and to revoke any such appointment from time to time, and to substitute or appoint any other or others in the place of such person as she, the said MARY L. STEWART, shall from time to time think fit.

And I, the said FINCHER STEWART, JR., do hereby ratify and confirm and promise at all times hereafter to ratify and confirm any and all things which the said MARY L. STEWART shall lawfully do or cause to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these presents, including anything which shall be done between the revocation of these presents by my death or in any other manner and notice of such revocation reaching her, and I do hereby declare that, as against me and all other persons claiming under me, everything which the said MARY L. STEWART shall do or cause to be done in pursuance hereof shall be valid and effectual in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof, who, before the doing thereof, shall not have had notice of such revocation.
