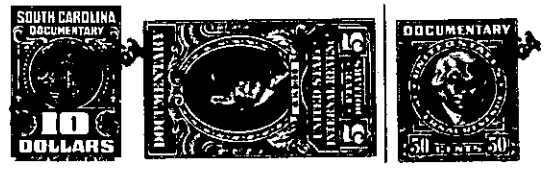

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known as **Lot No. 12 Chisolm Trail** of Section 2, Parkins Lake Development near Greenville, S. C. according to a plat made October 22, 1962 by R. K. Campbell, Engineer and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in Plat Book "YY" Page 93 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Chisolm Trail joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13 and running along Chisolm Trail N. 65-25 E. 55 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along Chisolm Trail N. 44-54 E. 65.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 34-42 E. 39 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots 12 and "A"; thence along the line of Lot "A" S. 29-29 E. 175.1 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots "A" and 12; thence S. 33-05 W. 285 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 12 and 13; thence along the line of Lot 13 N. 9-38 W. 294 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

Subject, however, to those protective covenants and restrictions and the easements reserved therein, as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in Deed Book 723, Page 105; and also a building set back line no less than 60 feet from the street.
