an iron pin in old road; thence along said old road S. 52-15 W., 501.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88-45 W., again crossing Harrison Bridge Road, 292.8 feet to the beginning corner and contains 85.25 acres, more or less.

This is a portion of that property which was conveyed to S. D. Knight by A. G. Huff by deed dated January 2, 1920, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 55, Page 146. Subsequently S. D. Knight died February 27, 1949, and by his Will which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S. C. in Apartment 566, File 1, he devised the above described property to his sons, John Knight, Odell Knight and S. D. Knight, Jr., as Trustees, to hold during the life time of his wife, Hattie Knight, and upon the death of the said Hattie Knight, the Trustees were directed to sell the property and divide the proceeds among the children of the said S. D. Knight. Hattie Knight has since died and the grantors herein are all of the children of S. D. Knight mentioned and referred to in said Will.

Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the grantees hereinabove named,
and the grantees' Heirs and Assigns against the grantors and the
grantors' Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
