Know All Men by These Presents:

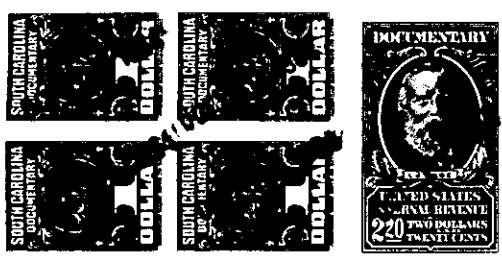

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina and being shown as Lot No. 9 on a plat of Oak Forest, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book CCC, Page 41 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Oak Forest Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 8 & 9 and running thence with the common line of said lots N. 12-10 W. 163.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 82-32 W. 100.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-10 E. 172 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Oak Forest Drive; thence with said Drive N. 77-50 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
