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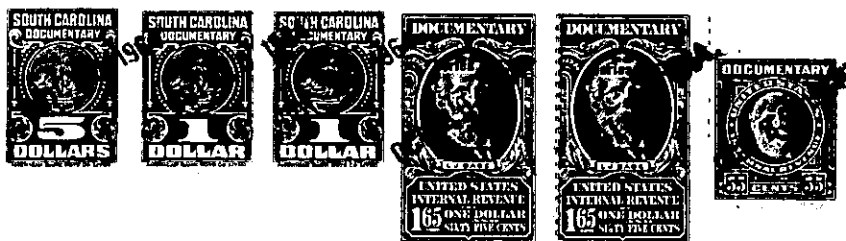

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto G. Maurice Ashmore, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 71 of Wellington Green, Section Two, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "YY", Page 117 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Kenilworth Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 70 and 71 and running thence along the line of Lot 70 N. 80-0 E. 175.0 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-0 W. 100.0 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 71 and 72; thence along the line of Lot 72 S. 80-0 W. 175.0 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Kenilworth Drive; thence along Kenilworth Drive S. 10-0 E. 100.0 feet to the beginning corner.
