All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, and being in the County of Greenville, near the Town of Fountain Inn (about one (1) mile northeast) shown as Lot 8, Block A, on a Plat of Friendship Heights made by W. N. Willis, dated May 30, 1960, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
