KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

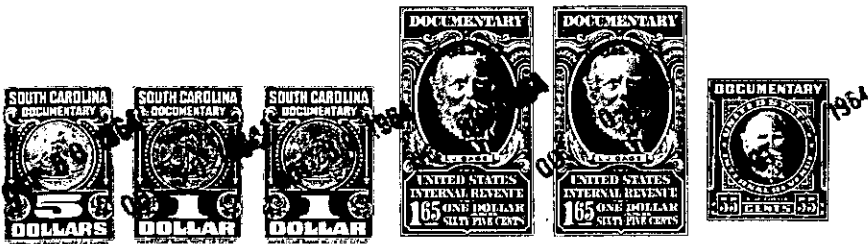
A Corporation chartered under the laws of the State of SOUTH CAROLINA and having a principal place of business at GREENVILLE, State of SOUTH CAROLINA, in consideration of * * * * * (\$3,500.00) Dollars, Three Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 * * * * * Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released; and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Walter W. Misenheimer and Lorene B. Misenheimer, their heirs and assigns

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown and designated as Lot No. 18 on plat of Drexel Terrace dated April 1, 1961, and prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at page 177, and being more particularly described with reference to said plat as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the northwesterly side of Rosebrier Lane, joint front corner of Lots 18 and 19 and running thence with the common boundary of said lots N. 47-53 W. 176 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots 18 and 19; thence turning and running along the rear line of Lot 18 N. 19-47 E. 188.5 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots 18 and 16; thence turning and running along the common boundary of Lots 18 and 16 S. 47-23 E. 120 feet to a point, being the rear corner of Lot 17; thence along the common boundary of Lots 18 and 17 S. 19-40 E. 172.4 feet to a point on Rosebrier Lane, joint front corner of Lots 18 and 17; thence turning and running along the northwesterly side of Rosebrier Lane S. 56-55 W. 95 feet to the point of beginning.

Said lot is subject to protective covenants for Drexel Terrace recorded on April 7, 1961 in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 671 at page 355 and to building set back line as shown on said plat.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the Grantor herein by deed of W. B. Simmons, recorded on April 3, 1961 in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 671 at page 155.
