. . .

8. The general nature of the business for which the corporation is organized is (it is not necessary to set forth in the purposes powers enumerated in Section 2.2) (12—12.2 Supplemental Code 1962) to own, maintain and operate an automatic car wash, to sell gasoline, oil and related automobile products; and to otherwise engage in any business which a business corporation is by law permitted to engage in under the laws of South Carolina.

9. Provisions which the incorporators elect to include in the articles of incorporation are as follows:
