3. All that piece, parcel or strip of land situate lying and being between the eastern boundary of the premises hereinabove described and the center line of the right of way for the National Highway.

It is the intention of the grantors herein to convey all their right, title and interest in and to all that property bounded on the North by the center line of the track of the Piedmont And Northern Railway Company, on the West by a creek and other property of the grantee herein, on the South by the center line of the right of way of the Southern Railway Company and the National Highway, and on the East by Beverly Road, as shown on the aforementioned plat.
