Deed for South Carolina

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, PHILIP N. BROWNSTEIN, of

Washington, D. C., as Federal Housing Commissioner, Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED AND 00/100 DOLLARS (\$8,500.00) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

ROBERT B. SHOCKLEY AND DOROTHY C. SHOCKLEY Grantee(s), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s), the following described real estate situate in the County of GREENVILLE, State of South Carolina, to wit:

Real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near Greenville, S. C., on the northern side of Piedmont Avenue and being known and designated as Lot No. 8 of McCain Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "J", at Page 59 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Piedmont Avenue at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 8 and 9 and running thence along said Avenue N. 57-58 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 7 N. 12-30 E. 302 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 76-45 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 9 S. 8-15 W. 336 feet to the point of beginning.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining or incident.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Grantee(s), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s) forever.

SUBJECT to all covenants, restrictions, reservations, easements, conditions and rights appearing of record; and SUBJECT to any state of facts an accurate survey would show.

AND THE SAID GRANTOR covenants that he has not made, done, committed, executed or suffered any act or acts, thing or things whatsoever, whereby or by means whereof, the above mentioned and described premises, or any part or parcel thereof, now are, or at any time hereafter shall or may be impeached, charged or encumbered in any manner or way whatsoever.
