In consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by me the said Grace Golightly, I do hereby sell, transfer and convey unto Jesse J. Bramlett, his heirs and assigns forever, a strip of right of way land over my said property located in Oneal Township, Greenville County, over which the old right of way has hereto fore been and said right of way shall be Thirty Feet wide accross my property along the old road bed right of way which has heretofore been used, with the right of egress and ingress to said property, with the right to pave and use said strip for the purposes of this conveyance.

I hereby bind my heirs, myself and assigns unto the purposes and intents of this instruments.

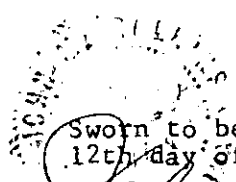
