to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Margaret H. Strickland and Walter T. Holliday, as Executors of the Estate of Agnes Mosteller Holliday, their Successors and assigns forever:

ALL OF MY RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO:

All that parcel or tract of land in Oneal Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the east side of the Holliday Road and on the southwest side of State Highway No. 14, and being all of that real estate owned and possessed by Agnes Mosteller Holliday at the time of her death and being shown on a plat made for the Agnes Mosteller Holliday Estate by John A. Simmons, Registered Surveyor, dated May 4, 1966, which plat is to be hereafter recorded. Reference to said plat and record thereof is expressly made for a more detailed description of this property.

This deed is executed for the purpose of relinquishing all right, title and interest of the grantor in and to the above described lands as derived by the grantor under the Last Will and Testament of Agnes Mosteller Holliday under Item IV of said Will, which is on record in the Probate Court of Greenville County.

It is understood that the grantor may retain possession and remain in the house where she is now living, located on the above described premises, until September 1, 1966, including lot on which house is situate.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

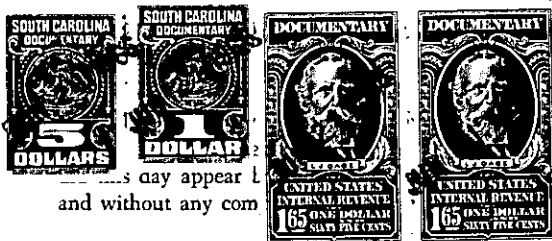
